

CASE COMPETITION 2017

We are pleased to announce that **The Center for Innovation and Entrepreneurship** is hosting a startup case competition with a focus on improving student life on campus!

\$2,000 award for the winning team!

THE CHALLENGE: You and your teammates are responsible for the ideation of a startup that somehow improves student life at the Claremont Colleges. The idea could be anything from a mobile application, to a hardware product, to a student business. Each team will pitch their startup ventures to a panel of expert judges who will decide the winning team. Each pitch should address the following:

- Identification and summary of campus issue
- How the proposed venture will solve this issue
- Venture implementation plan and marketing strategies
- Future growth plan including cost and revenue breakdown

WHAT: In-person presentation (maximum of 10-minute pitch + 5-minute Q&A), to be evaluated by a panel of CMC professionals including faculty, staff, alumni, and members of the CIE Board of Directors.

WHO: Limited to twelve teams of four current 7C students. Sign ups will be collected via Google Form on a first come, first serve basis starting at **12:30pm on Tuesday, September 5th**. Team submissions must include the names and emails of all team members. By submitting your team you are committing to participate in all scheduled events.
